The committee visited Harlow Carr for an Eco workshop, it provided them with ideas for our school and they learnt about how to build an eco-building. They had to think of three BIG ideas to bring back to school;

Make sure the back door of school is closed at break time to stop all the heat being wasted

Explain to the class Eco monitors what their role is and make badges.

Think about how to design a new Eco School

We discussed what has gone good and what can be improved upon to ensure that we continue to be an eco-school and have revised their action plan with new targets.

Energy: Need to reinforce the message to everyone, make sure the classroom monitors know who they are and what their job is.

The door to the playground is still left open sometimes at break time. Mrs Mansfield is going to make a sign for it and the Eco team are going to make sure it is closed.

Water: Everything is in place to monitor the water usage and the committee feel that it is just about continuing the message and making more interesting posters.

Litter & Rubbish there is still a big problem with litter in the playground the committee has decided to write to FONSS to ask if they would fund the purchase of a new special bin to try to help the problem.

The committee are going to continue to reinforce the message to everyone in school and are hoping to have class assemblies this term to share more Eco-News
