The Team are working toward the Bronze Eco School Award, there are nine areas that must be looked at in schools.



The first task was to complete the pupil environmental review for our school, the team made the following points;

Energy

- The lights are not always turned off in rooms and corridors that are not being used
- Computers and monitors and projectors are not always turned off when not being used
- Took a meter reading on the British gas monitor of 253977 at 9.48am

Water

- The push taps in the pupil toilets run for a long time wasting water
- When the taps are dripping or the toilets are not flushing or clean The School need to tell adults

Waste
