Dear Parents / Guardians,

I am writing to keep you informed about the class structures for next year.

I feel very strongly about the welfare and progress of your children and am absolutely determined not to structure our classes in any way that is not going to be the best for them.

Our building causes us to think carefully about the structure of our classes as some rooms are at absolute capacity at 18.

I have still not heard back from the Local Authority so I have made a decision about the classes but as yet cannot fully inform you about the teacher.

The year 2 children will still spend plenty of time learning outside and inside through a practical curriculum and will spend time in Class 1 with the younger children.

Class 1 – Miss Gregory and Mrs Gray – R and Y1 - currently 12 children

Class 2 – Mrs Watts and /or another – Y2 and Y3 - currently 12 children

Class 3 – Mrs Wilson and /or another – Y4 and Y5 – currently 20 children

Class 4 – Miss Williamson – Y6 – currently 15 children.

On our new starter transition afternoons, I would like our Y2 children to have a transition to their new class and spend time as a class. So on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> June, Friday 6<sup>th</sup> July and Friday 13<sup>th</sup> July they will spend the afternoon upstairs in Class 2. This also allows our lovely new starters to settle into their new class with only the children who will be in there in September.

Year 3 will spend the afternoon doing PE and Forest Schools with our HLTA Mrs MacArthur.

We will ensure that all our children from y3 to Y5 have a transition to their new class nearer the end of term, when hopefully staffing is fully sorted.
