Phonics:

This weeks sound(s): *w*

This is the last set 2 sound, so it would be a huge advantage to practise all the set 2 sounds!

w: toy for a boy

Practise saying the rhyme, writing the sounds in different words you can think of- but be careful, it is a sound that can be written in multiple ways!

Extension: Can you put those words into a sentence and write it?

Can you find this sound around the house, in your reading book or a book in your home?

Spellings: Can you put these into sentences as you practise?

Hold a sentence: The boy was loud. I like to annoy my mum.

Hold a sentence: *Adult says the sentence, children have to remember and write it, remembering their finger spaces, capital letters, full stops and correct phonics spellings.*
